4 SUIT DINOSAURS

2 Utahraptors 2.5m tall x 4m long **2 baby dinosaur puppets**
1 Baby T-rex 2m tall x 4m long **3 Baby Plateosaurus**
1 Liliensternus 2m tall x 5m long

EACH LARGE DINOSAUR CONTAINS: (BASED UPON THE CONSTRUCTION OF A TOROSAUR)

EACH LARGE DINOSAUR:

Weighs 1500 kilograms a piece (standard family car)
Runs on 6 roller blade wheels

TO OPERATE ONE DINOSAUR, IT TAKES:

A Team of 3 people
1 Driver, 2 Voodoo Puppeteers -
One operates head and tail gross motion,
One in charge of minor movements: mouth, blinking and roars

TRUCKS

21 - 14.5m trailers

TOURING COMPANY

52 cast and crew including performers, voodoo operators, puppeteers, dinosaur drivers, maintenance staff (for the dinosaurs), carpenter, riggers and multiple engineers, lighting, video and sound personnel
